

10 VOTES THAT INFLUENCE YOUR HEALTH

Sheriff



Sheriffs play a key role in local law enforcement, such as influencing how first responders manage mental health crises

Commissioner



Commissioners introduce and vote on health policies for their community, like funding for local parks programs

Judge



Judges play a role in decisions such as mental health laws, substance use protocols, and fines

Treasurer



Treasurers manage community budgets, ensuring resources are distributed to address community concerns

Attorney General



Attorneys General choose the lawsuits they pursue for their state or local community

State Senator or Representative



State-elected officials introduce and vote on health policies, such as funding for health research like on Alzheimer's disease

U.S. Senator or Representative



U.S. elected officials introduce and vote on health policies such as rules for programs like Medicare
